Fireside's 14 Point Annual Maintenance Work Includes:

1. Safety test the gas valve to verify correct drop out time and operation.
2. Check/repair wall switch/thermostat/wiring connection resistance to insure proper performance.
3. Check and adjust thermo generator voltage to insure proper performance.
4. Visually inspect the heat exchanger and structure for cracks.
5. Check and adjust air/fuel ratio as required to reduce sooting and improve efficiency.
6. Check and adjust pilot flame to insure proper ignition and thermo generator performance.
7. Check and adjust burner flames to provide best appearance.
8. Inspect and adjust logs and large embers to provide best appearance.
9. Add glowing embers as appropriate to the logs to improve appearance.
10. Inspect for burner cracks to insure proper and safe operation.
11. Inspect glass casketing to insure proper sealing.
12. Clean glass to reduce etching and improve appearance.
13. Reinstall all the components that were removed for inspection and cleaning.
14. Check operation of various features as needed to insure proper operation.

Occasionally, worn out or defective components are found during the inspection and their replacement part is an extra cost.
